Declaration by the State

1. In accordance with the decision of 5.11.07 by Her Honor Chief Justice Beinisch, respondents 1-4 (hereinafter – **The State**) wish to submit this additional declaration with a view to the upcoming session on the petition, which has been set for 6.2.2008.
2. The issue of the petition in the Petitioners' request to instruct the State to explain why it has not taken all measures necessary to evacuate the illegal outpost of Migron (hereinafter – **Migron**), including the issuing or a delineating injunction for the area and its implementation, the issuing of stop work injunctions and demolition injunctions and their implementation.
3. The State should like to update and inform the Honorable Court, that the Prime Minister and the Minister of Defense have decided that Migron, which is situated on private land belonging to Palestinians, shall be evacuated within six months, that is, by the beginning of August 2008.

The Prime Minister and the Minister of Defense also decided that during that period, an attempt shall be made to evacuate the residents willingly to another site, which shall be available from the legal and infrastructure points of view.

It was also decided that should, during the above period, significant steps are taken to leave Migron willingly, the Defense system reserves the right to ask the Honorable Court for an additional extension for the evacuation

of Migron, in order to make it possible to complete the arrangements for the evacuation.
