Cabinet Resolution 4090, dated 9/8/2005:
Prioritizing: Bolstering the City of Jerusalem

"We hereby decide:

- "1. To bolster Jerusalem's status as the capital of the State of Israel and to allocate NIS 50 million in each of the budget years of 2006-2013 for the renovation, development, and maintenance of the Old City basin and the Mount of Olives. A detailed multiyear plan of these issues, in the framework of the said approved state budget, will be devised by the Prime Minister's Office director general, the official in charge of budgets in the Finance Ministry, and the Jerusalem Municipality CEO.*

The plan's execution will be handled by the Jerusalem Development Authority [JDA], which will report on the performance of its tasks back to the aforementioned team of directors general.

The budgets will be managed as a closed financial system, using subcontractors.

- "2. In addition to the instructions of Clause 1 above, a sum of at least NIS 10 million from the annual tourism budget will be earmarked in 2006-2013 for the financing of tourist projects in the Old City.*
- "3. To order the Ministry of Transportation to build Road 20, at some NIS 80 million from the ministry's budget for urban roads for FY 2006-7."*
